

School Closure Work: Year 1

Please dip in and out of these ideas. It is a good idea to focus on the Core Subjects. The children are not expected to complete every single piece of work suggested. They usually have periods of 30 minutes when they are required to concentrate, then a short break and another lesson. They should put all work completed into a folder and bring this in to School when they return, for marking/review.

English	Revise spelling lists from the last term, and learn high frequency words. Write a diary account of each day that you are off school. Read for 15 minutes every day – aloud to an adult when possible.
Maths	Read and write whole numbers to 100. Double and half numbers within 50. Count on and count back by playing board games, for example Snakes and Ladders. Have a go at making your own version!
Science	Materials – make a list of all the different materials used in your home, and illustrate neatly. Revisit the topic ‘Animals including Humans’ – draw and illustrate how you have changed over time (from when you were a baby to until now).
Humanities	Keep a weather diary for each day that you are off school.
