

School Closure Work: Year 2

Please dip in and out of these ideas. It is a good idea to focus on the Core Subjects. The children are not expected to complete every single piece of work suggested. They usually have periods of 30 minutes when they are required to concentrate, then a short break and another lesson. They should put all work completed into a folder and bring this in to School when they return, for marking/review.

English	<p>Revise previous spelling lists, and learn high frequency words.</p> <p>Write a diary account of each day that you are off school.</p> <p>Read for 15 minutes every day – aloud to an adult when possible.</p>
Maths	<p>Continue to practise times tables up to the 12s.</p> <p>Continue to practise number bonds – 10, 20 and 100.</p> <p>Log in to Purple Mash and complete the activities set.</p>
Science	<p>Create an information sheet (no bigger than A4) on different materials that you can find in your home. How many natural ones can you find? How many manmade?</p> <p>Draw a picture of your home. Divide it into the following: kitchen, living room, bedroom and bathroom. Inside each room draw and label some things that use electricity.</p>
Humanities	<p>Research a 'famous person' of your choice and write an account of their life.</p>
